BAPTIST WORLD AID

Right through Scripture, God is portrayed as the earths' creator and owner (Job 49:11), it's sustainer (Heb 1:3; Ps 147:8-9,15-18), it's director (Isa 40:15,22-24), and it's redeemer (Rom 8:20-22; Cor 4:16-5:5). From the fields of Cambodia and Uganda to the villages of Nepal and Malawi, Baptist World Aid programs have long integrated environmental practices that help the communities. We've had to because those most effected by environmental crises such as natural disasters, loss of natural resources and sea level rise are those who've contributed least to them. Responding to disasters only as they happen just isn't sustainable long term.

When Aluna's husband died, her future and the futures of her 8 children were uncertain. Aluna grew small amounts of food on her land, but not enough to live on. At the same time, the environment was changing, previously successful crops didn't flourish, and drinkable water became scarce.

Fortunately, our Christian partners in Kenya have run developmental programs that incorporate climate resilience for decades. Aluna and her community learnt to adapt to the changing climate, ensuring they and other vulnerable communities have access to water and the knowledge, skills and resources to grow climate resilient crops. Aluna can now feed her family, earn an income from the food she grows and send her children to school.
