The Buddhist Lent period extends from August through to October, the rainy season in Thailand. Buddhists use this time to cleanse themselves of the "bad" in their life and often make pledges to abstain from certain practises such as drinking alcohol. Buddhist monks spend this time at the temple studying Buddha's scriptures, meditating, and chanting. It is common practise for a Thai monk to wake well before the sun has risen to chant, meditate and prav.


Special Church Meeting
