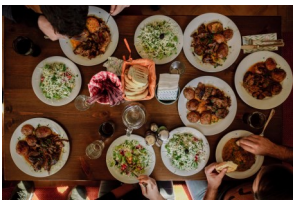


October Prayer Theme – Strengthening our Faith
