Mission Spot-HopeStreet



Last year, Henry* and his mum Lucy* fled from violence into homelessness. This year, he started high school. Together they are breaking barriers to create a safe and stable home. Lucy is among the 72,900 people who asked for help from

specialist homelessness services in 2021-22, due to domestic violence.

Our HopeStreet team was able to walk beside both Lucy and Henry, linking them with services, advocating for their housing journey, and providing ongoing support to give them more choices in life. One of the first services they were able to access was counselling as victims of crime.





From a temporary refuge accommodation, they finally found a more permanent place with the help of HopeStreet. Our team provided Lucy and Henry with everything they could, from low-cost groceries to a chest of drawers and mattresses. "Outside of our scope, the community came together with beautiful tubs of kitchenware and laundry packs. I was able to get

referrals to other support agencies to obtain whitegoods and yard mowing services," their caseworker added.

Lucy is full of gratitude and is now able to actively participate in life. rather than worrying about where she and her son will sleep at night.
