Mission Spot- (GRN) Global Recording Network

The Orality Network suggests that almost 80% of the world's population is oral-preference learning. More people engage in Bible materials in their own language if it



is in audio form rather than a literate paper form. That is why GRN keeps training people to equip Christians, whether GRN or from a different agency, to make resources available in people's heart language in a way that does not depend on literacy skills. In October, the Australian Office hosted several senior GRN recordists from South Africa, Pakistan, Cameroon, the Philippines and Thailand for a Recording Trainers Consultation. The consultation covered technical training matters for our recordists and also discussed a way forward to update the content of our scripts. Pray for God's provision for new staff and volunteers to fulfil various roles in GRN - accountant, property and maintenance manager, software developers and more recordists.



Pray too for the team in France recording our 'The Living Christ' stories and teachings of Jesus into standard Arabic for refugees in Europe. The project is to 1) Translate 'The Living Christ' into Standard Arabic 2) Find an Egyptian Arabic speaker who reads well 3) Record the freshly translated script 4) Produce the

recording in several audio and video formats 5) Inform those working with refugees about using the program in their ministry

We received an email from **Stephen & Jocelyn Head** in New Zealand this week. They worshipped for a short time with us at Carlingford over 20 years ago. Their Heartstream Resources ministry of retreats and spiritual direction will be concluding at the end of this year, so they can be more involved in their local church's ministry.
